INTRODUCTION


The Office for International Study Programs (OISP) conducted data collection from June 30th to July 30th 2019 through sending survey questionnaires to each lecturer, including:

- Total number of lecturers surveyed: 227
- Total number of respondents: 141
- Total number of valid answers: 110

 4. Materials for teaching
 5. Learning attitude of OISP students
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RESULTS AND DIRECTION OF IMPROVEMENT 2020

- Over the past few years, OISP has been investing heavily to improve quality of the above criteria.
- In 2019, OISP approved the plan to purchase more than 1,000 textbooks and reference materials for subjects of English programs and advanced program.
- In terms of facilities, OISP renovated buildings B9, B10, B6, B8; repaired of teaching equipment; equipping and upgrading the internet system for educational purposes.
- In 2020, OISP is planning to renovate A4 library, Hoa Binh lecture hall, classrooms and self-study areas in buildings B1 and B2; and continue investing in equipment and renovate laboratory facilities in the faculties.
- In addition, OISP continues to organize seminars, competitions, "Buddy Program", teaching assistance classes, etc. in order for students to improve their learning capacity, soft skills, professional skills and career awareness./.
