November Graduation

On November 8th, Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology (HCMUT) Bach Khoa solemnly organized a Graduation Ceremony for fresh Doctors, Masters, Engineers, Architectures, Bachelors.

In this graduation period, there are 14 Doctors, 231 Masters and over 2500 fresh engineers, architectures and bachelors. Especially, the Faculty of Computer Science and Engineering had a twin, Mai Le Thong and Mai Le Thai, who graduated with excellent results and Mai Le Thai is the valedictorian with a graduation grade of 9.32.

At the ceremony, apart from giving graduation certificates for fresh Doctors, Masters, Engineers, Architectures, Bachelors, the university also praised 3 Masters and 51 students receiving gold medals of their major, awarded certificate of merit to 1 student of the part-time undergraduate program, 1 student of the college program with the best academic results.

Sharing at the ceremony, Assoc. Prof. Mai Thanh Phong - Rector of HCMUT Bach Khoa said: "Today, you are graduating in a very promising scenario. The Industrial Revolution 4.0 with the focus on creativity, knowledge, and science, technology is a great opportunity for you who are equipped with engineering, technological strong foundation. However, in order to meet integration and development requirements, you will need to accumulate not only knowledge but also bravery, culture basis, working skills, social skills to keep pace with high-quality human resource requirements in the knowledge economy.

According to the university's raw data, 95% of graduates already got a job in prestigious enterprises, domestic, foreign organizations, offices, especially Japanese, Korean markets, etc. This affirms the credibility and reputation of HCMUT Bach Khoa in meeting social and international standards.

The graduation ceremony received a lot of attention from the press, media to attend and inform about such as Tuoi Tre News, Thanh Nien, Dan Tri, Vietnamnet, Baomoi, VTV24News, etc.

Twin Graduates with Excellent Results



Out of more than 2500 students of Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology (Vietnam National University HCM) graduating this November, there are 2 fresh twin engineers with excellent graduation results.

The twin, Mai Le Thai, and Mai Le Thong, (born 1997 in HCMC) both studied Computer Science. Thai chose one taught in English, Thong's option was the Vietnamese program. In this graduation, there are only 6 students graduating with excellent results and the twin were two out of them. Moreover, Thai is also the valedictorian of all English programs and awarded a gold medal of Computer Science, English program with a GPA of 9.32 and IELTS 7.0.

"For the Computer-related programs, most of the reading materials are in English. Both of us studied English complementary class since we were little and frequently listened, read the news in English, thus we have more advantages than others." – Thong shared.

How to achieve high scores in university? The twins revealed that they often dig deeper into reference books teachers suggested. "Most of the lectures were shortened, summarized from the books, thus it might be difficult to understand just based on the lecture, we should study more from the books." – Thong said. Through 4 years of studying, both were awarded scholarships and pay for tuition fees by that money.

Currently, Thai is working for KMS technology (USA), while Thong is working at Zalo in the Server Backend department. Both were invited to work after finishing industry internship, at the same time, they continued to study master programs in Bach Khoa.



Aeroday 2019 – Aircraft Design And Control Competition

Aircraft Design and Control Competition – Aeroday 2019 organized by Aerospace Engineering – Faculty of Transportation Engineering Bach Khoa on November 3rd successfully brought an exciting atmosphere and attracted many students to participate and support.

The competition had 11 teams competing, which were founded by Bach Khoa students from intake 2014 to 2017 majoring in Aerospace Engineering. The competition took place in the framework of aerospace festival on November 24 to start off "designation, manufacture, flying model control" playground for Aerospace Engineering students.

Thanks to this competition, the subject and club of the aerospace models aimed to develop Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) for scientific research, academic exchange, reality application. The competition had sorted out 2 teams representing the program to participate in International UAV in Thailand in January 2020 with participation from many teams in Thailand universities, Taiwan, Korea, Japan, Vietnam.







Bach Khoa Students and First Prize in National English Olympiad 2019

Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology (HCMUT) Bach Khoa – VNU HCMC student group excellently won first prize of Southern area at Final round of English Olympiad 2019 – E4US Contest 2019 on October 24 at the University of Social Sciences and Humanities HCMC.

At the final round of E4US Contest 2019 for Southern area, 5 teams from Dong Thap University, PetroVietNam University, Ho Chi Minh City University of Law, Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology – VNU HCM, VNU HCM School of Medicine gave excellent performances with enthusiastic support from teachers and volunteers.

After 3 rounds: introduction, knowledge and public speaking about the topic "Students' roles in sustainable development", UTEC – student group from HCMUT Bach Khoa excellently won the first prize and the chance to advance to National Final round which will be organized at Hanoi National University in November 2019.

As announced, this year National English Olympiad was organized with expanded scale, targeted at students from universities, institutes, colleges teaching English as a major, it attracted 55 teams from universities nationwide. Apart from creating opportunities to meet, discuss and exchange foreign language study experience and enhance understanding among students from universities nationwide, the contest also encouraged students to learn and practice English. Especially, from the topic of the contest, students have chances to voice their opinions upon social concerned problems, recommend ideas, solutions to contribute to society, the country.





Bach Khoa Students and SSEAYP 2019 Representatives

The meet and greet took place on November 11, 2019, in the framework of the Ship for Southeast Asian and Japanese Youth Programme (SSEAYP) of which Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology (HCMUT) is one out of nine destinations in Vietnam.

Members from OISP Student Ambassadors (OSA), OISP English Club (OEC), House of OISP Pioneering Elements (HOPE) and OISP Youth Union are Bach Khoa representatives to welcome SSEAYP delegates.

SSEAYP is the result of the agreement between Japan and the 5 founders of ASEAN in 1974. This is an annual cultural exchange program held by Japan government and 10 ASEAN members including Vietnam, Cambodia, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore, Brunei, Philippines, and Myanmar.

HCMUT Bach Khoa takes pride in being one out of nine destinations for sightseeing, meet and greet and exchange the culture of SSEAYP in Vietnam.

In the meet and greet, 40 SSEAYP 2019 representatives together with Bach Khoa students discussed enthusiastically the theme "Disaster risk reduction and restoration" though smaller topics such as Impact of climate change in Vietnam, Solutions to adapt with climate change in Vietnam, Water sustainable development methods – energy and food to adapt with climate change in Vietnam, Approaches to enhance treatment capability, cope with environmental incidents and disasters' consequences.

Starting from November 4th, 2019, the Ship for Southeast Asian and Japanese Youth Programme (SSEAYP) with the name "Nippon Maru" brought 328 young representatives of 10 ASEAN members and Japan. In the 52-day voyage, the ship stopped at Tan Cang harbor – Hiep Phuoc (Nha Be District) from November 10 to 13, at which they started meet and greet activities with HCMC youth before visiting Singapore, Myanmar, Malaysia then back to Japan.

In the time staying in HCMC, SSEAYP 2019 representatives took part in gala performances, cultural exchange with HCMC youth in universities, Ho Chi Minh City Media Center, HCMC Youth Employment Service Center, Saigon Innovation Hub and went sightseeing famous destinations.







Bach Khoa OISP Students Got Two First Prizes in English Speaking Day Open 2019

Bach Khoa student group participated in the competition are members of the OISP English Club – OEC.

English Speaking Day Open 2019 (ESD 2019) is the English speaking event organized by BELL Club from the University of Economics Ho Chi Minh City Student Union for students all over the city including students, pupils from universities, high schools in Ho Chi Minh city. The event aimed to bring an exciting moment and release English learners from fear of speaking English.

There are two main activities in the event: (1) Booth Contest: engaging and playing English challenges at booth, (2) Battle Contest: show English eloquence through debates about topics from judges.

OEC won the first prize in both activities.

OEC is an English club of OISP Bach Khoa students which works to promote "Practice English in an Entertaining Way". OEC was founded with 2 main objectives:

Create an environment for students to practice, accumulate and improve English in the most entertaining way for OISP students particularly and HCMUT Bach Khoa in general.

Support, encourage OISP students to improve their English and achieve IELTS grade \geq 6.0 on time to enter the main course.

In order to make it, OEC frequently organized various offline activities such as Movie Days, Speaking with Foreigners, IELTS Trial Test, Weekly Debate English Camp. These activities are held weekly from 9 am to 11 am Sunday at Room 407, A4 Building, Campus 1, Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology, 268 Ly Thuong Kiet, District 10.


Congratulations to candidates qualified to be professors, associate professors by The State Council for Professorship
